

Statement by CAS on Cracking Down on the Unauthorized Sales and Use of CAS SciFinder® Database

Dear Partners and Users:

CAS, a division of the American Chemical Society (“ACS”), is the sole intellectual property rights holder and operator of the CAS SciFinder® database (“CAS SciFinder®”).

Recently, we have identified a significant number of unauthorized sales of CAS SciFinder® on various online trading platforms (including but not limited to Taobao) and third-party websites, for profit. These sellers provided unauthorized access to CAS SciFinder® to their customers, thereby enabling a significant number of users who have not obtained access to CAS SciFinder® through CAS’s official authorization distribution channels to illegally access and use CAS SciFinder®, and this action seriously infringes upon CAS’s IP Rights and results in significant economic losses for CAS. CAS reserves all rights to take any and all necessary and appropriate legal actions to remedy the misuse of its IP Rights.

CAS hereby issues a solemn statement that legitimate access to CAS SciFinder® can only be authorized and provided by CAS, CAS has never authorized any third-party to sell access accounts to CAS SciFinder® through online trading platforms. The unauthorized use of CAS SciFinder® constitutes an infringement on CAS’s IP Rights. The unauthorized sale of CAS SciFinder® accounts constitutes illegal sale and piracy. The unauthorized access to or use of CAS SciFinder® constitutes infringement. The above actions all constitute severe infringement of CAS and its intellectual property rights over CAS SciFinder®.

CAS hereby reminds all partners and users to avoid obtaining, purchasing, and using CAS SciFinder® through unauthorized accounts to avoid suffering losses and assuming legal risks.
